Thank you for your support over the past few weeks; the newsletter includes some dates for your diary for the next half-term.

PFA School Disco

The PFA are putting on a school disco for the children on Tuesday 14th March 2023, at the Parish Centre (see separate flyer). The EY and KS1 (Yr Nursery, Reception, Yr 1 & Yr 2) disco will be held 5-6pm, and the KS2 (Yrs 3-6) disco will be held 6:30-7:30pm. We are going to provide a hot meal for the children, to make it easier for parents to manage the logistics and more exciting for the children, and therefore the cost will be £6 per ticket; they will also receive a bag of sweets to take home.

Once we have received your orders, payment will be requested using our usual parent pay service. Please could you complete this form by 1st March. We cannot accept cash on the door, so all tickets must be ordered and paid for in advance.

Just a reminder that this disco is only for children who attend St Herbert's School, and they must have been in attendance on the day of the disco (if they are poorly they cannot then come to the disco). Parents will drop off the children at the parish centre door, and collect again at the designated time please!
