Dear Children, Parents and Families,

Welcome back after the February half term. Hopefully we will soon start to see spring flowers making an appearance along with some brighter days.

Firstly, the Governors would like to remind you that the School Crossing Patrol on Middleton Road is due to cease on the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017. As previously mentioned, serious consideration had been taken by the Governors before this decision was made.

**St. Herbert's Island Annual Pilgrimage** This year it is on **Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> April**. School and the Parish join together to travel to Keswick. We sail across Derwent Water and celebrate Mass with Fr. McKie by the lake. Free time is then available in the afternoon to spend around Keswick. The coach leaves from the Church at 8.30am and returns at 6.30pm approximately. This is a wonderful experience for you to enjoy and most years the weather has been kind and the sun has shone. The trip is subsidised by Fr. McKie, enabling the cost to remain at **£14 for adults and £8 for children**. The Pilgrimage is for families, so all children must be accompanied.

**School Uniform** A quick reminder that school uniform consists of grey trousers/skirt, white blouse/shirt, school tie, St Herbert's school jumper and black shoes (no boots or trainers). After Easter, in the summer term, boys may wear grey school shorts and white polo shirts and girls may wear green and white gingham dresses. Children may wear watches and small stud earrings, but all jewellery must be removed for any form of PE. Long hair should be tied back at all times (no fancy hair styles please!).

**World Book Day** This year we are celebrating World Book day on **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March**. The theme is a 'Bedtime Story' and we are asking that children wear their nightclothes (pyjamas, onesies, dressing gowns etc). A change of footwear will be needed for playing out if they are wearing slippers.

**Parent's Evening** This will be on **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> April 3.15pm – 7.15pm**. A separate letter will be sent out nearer the time for you to choose your preferential time slot.

**Easter Holidays** School finishes on **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> April at 1.30pm** and re-opens on **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April**.

Please note that SAT's week is week commencing **8<sup>th</sup> May**. It is VITAL that your child attends school in that week. Thank you for your support in this matter.
