Staffing

Mrs Lovell, our KS1 phase leader, will be going on a secondment as a Deputy Headteacher to support another school after Christmas. The secondment will be from January through to July 2024, and therefore Mrs Whale (Chadderton) will be going into Class 3, with Mrs Kendrick joining her after her maternity leave finishes at Easter. Mr Cleary will continue to work with Class 6, in a full-time capacity, for the remainder of the academic year. We send Mrs Lovell our best wishes, and know she will do a fantastic job of supporting one of our schools in their time of need.

After 31 years of serving our school, Mrs Kay (who works in KS1 and EY), will be retiring (very early retirement!!!). We thank her for all her years' service and send her and her family our love and best wishes for a wonderful retirement.

Attendance

The local authorities are focusing on schools' attendance, following a dip nationally since the pandemic. The national attendance figure has not risen back to pre-pandemic standards as expected, and therefore there is now a large focus to get pupils back into schools consistently. The LA school attendance officer is visiting all schools and visited our school last week; we will be focusing on any pupils whose attendance falls below 90% / who are persistently late.

Any absence will be unauthorised if current attendance is under 90%, unless families can provide medical evidence/cards/texts. If your child has an appointment in school time, we will need to see a medical appointment card or text at the office.

Whilst our school attendance is very good, the school attendance officer is working with us and our families to improve in a couple of areas, in particular punctuality. Lateness can have a significant impact on pupil's attainment, as often they are missing key learning at this time, and therefore we will be monitoring punctuality carefully.

We wish to work with families, and thank you for your support in this area.
